75th Annual NSFA Training Conference...

The Winnemucca Volunteer Fire Department is both honored and proud to host this 75th landmark celebration. For this year's training conference, we endeavor to provide a unique experience for all attendees. "75 Years of Dedication" will be held in Winnemucca on June 23 through June 26, 2010. The training conference, registration and vendor exhibits will be held at both the East and West Halls of the Winnemucca Convention Center, 50 W Winnemucca Blvd with outdoor demonstrations/training held across the street, at the Winnemucca Volunteer Fire Department, City Golf Course and other sites around our friendly community. The festivities will culminate with a **Firemen's Ball** and raffle immediately following the banquet. Wednesday will kick the event off with pre conference training by the Nevada State Fire Marshall's Division entitled "Burn Prop Train-the-Trainer" Program open to all departments to allow for greater use of the Wendover Burn Trailer. A golf scramble at the Winnemucca City Golf Course will be held in the afternoon followed by a reunion BBQ on the lawn of the Convention Center. The Manipulative Skills contests will be held early Thursday and Friday at the historic WVFD building on Bridge Street. On Thursday afternoon, a **Poker/21 Tournament** for spouses, a men's/women's bowling tournaments at the Spare Time Bowling Center, 777 S Bridge Street, and a nighttime trap shoot under the lights are all planned with a light BBQ fare and refreshments made available by the WVFD during the trap shoot. A **Wine Walk** is planned for Friday afternoon followed by dinner and horseshoes at Vesco Park. There will be many training opportunities; vendor exhibits, demonstrations such as high angle rescue by local Mine, Search, and Rescue teams, extrication evolutions, EMS coordination scenarios, burn trailer evolutions, real world ICS interdepartmental training, hazardous waste materials evolutions, FF Health and Safety Discussion, FF Obstacle Courses, and much more. This year's keynote speaker will be many of your state legislators in an open forum, giving you the opportunity for a face to face Q and A re: Nevada's fire service. A Preview of Conference Instructors

Various State Legislators, Keynote Speaker(s)

This years Keynote speaker will be many of your State Legislators in an open forum, giving you the opportunity for a face to face Question and Answers period regarding Nevada's Fire Service.

Nevada State Fire Marshals Office – Training Division

The SFMO Training Division will be presenting *“Burn Prop Train-the-Trainer”*. This 4-hour short course will enable firefighters to safely operate the various Burn Props that Nevada has throughout the state. Additionally, the Burn Props will be available for burning on Friday only. All participants must attend a mandatory safety training program lasting approximately 30 minutes prior to any live fire training.

Hal Phillips, Lieutenant

Winnemucca City Volunteer Fire Department

Hal Phillips is the Lieutenant/Assistant Training Officer for the Winnemucca City Volunteer Fire Department. He has been in the fire service for over 10 years. Three years were spent as a full-time Firefighter/EMT for the City of Susanville Fire Department and seven years with the Winnemucca City Volunteer Fire Department. Hal Phillips will be presenting the Firefighter Obstacle Course. This course will consist of several different stations including crawling through confined spaces and having to properly remove your SCBA, simulated ceiling collapse, entanglement, and having to identify which way to follow a hose out of a structure. Some stations will include the use of simulated smoke.

Mike Johnson, Assistant Chief

Clark County Fire Department

Chief Johnson is the Assistant Chief for Clark County Fire Department in charge of the 13 Volunteer Fire Stations covering a diverse area from Wildland/Urban interface to interstate road travel. Prior to his current position, he spent many years as a Training Instructor teaching topics including ICS, Wildland, Driver Operator, Firefighter I/II, and Fire Science. He has worked for the US Forest Service and College of Southern Nevada, suppressing fire in the summertime and teaching various fire classes in the winter. Chief Johnson has also been a member of the NSFA since 2006. Chief Johnson will be presenting *“Real World ICS”*. This short course will enable firefighters to utilize the incident command with greater ease at any type of incident.

Steve Cochrane

Cyanco

Mr. Steve Cochrane is the Environmental, Safety and Health Manager at Cyanco's Liquid Sodium Cyanide Product. Facility in Winnemucca, Nevada where he has worked for 18 years. He worked at the plant for three years as a Plant Operator prior to moving into the Environmental and Safety fields. He has degrees in Communications and Occupational Safety and Health. He qualified as a Hazardous Materials On Scene Incident Commander and Technician level responder and he has served on the Humboldt County LEPC for several years. Mr. Cochrane will be presenting information to first responders responding to Cyanide emergencies.
